







EVERS BOULEVARD CORRIDOR WALK

The Cheyenne Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), City of Cheyenne, and Ayres Associates are embarking on a design process to improve Evers Boulevard, from Bishop Boulevard to Brittany Drive.

Project Goals:

- Address drainage concerns
- Safely accommodate all users: pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles
- Provide a welcoming gateway to the Western Hills neighborhood
- Design the corridor to address the specific needs of the residents and users of this roadway
- Develop a solid conceptual plan for this corridor which can be used as a foundation for the engineering design necessary for the reconstruction of Evers Boulevard, a project which is on the 5th Penny Sales Tax ballot (election November 4, 2014).

On Saturday, September 13th, you are invited to meet the planning and design team while they walk along the corridor to interact with the residents. The team is just beginning the planning process and wants to listen to ideas, needs and concerns that you may have, as well as to identify specific features that may present opportunities or challenges to design solutions.
