WHAT THE ISSUES ARE

Evers Blvd. is in generally poor condition and contains drainage concerns. Wide travel lanes, narrow attached sidewalks with a center turn lane provides an environment where cars can easily pick up speed traveling downhill.

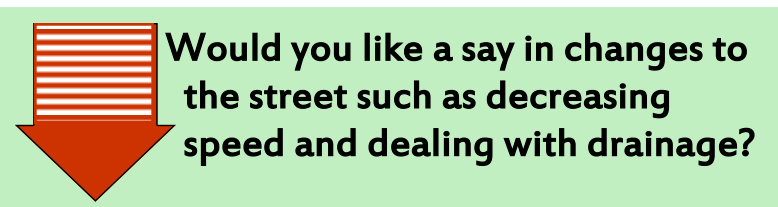
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PROJECT GOALS
