4. **Voting to Approve:** [UPWP Revised](#) – Two items were changed in the UPWP, and the MPO is currently requesting Technical Committee recommended approval to the Policy Committee.

The first item (Section 4-1), Titled "***IntuVision Support License – \$40,000.00***", The MPO could not agree on the price with IntuVision for software and changed to "***RD Analytics Support License – \$40,000.00***", RD Analytics is a video-based traffic data analysis software used to support MPO transportation planning activities. The platform processes recorded roadway videos to produce turning-movement counts, approach volumes, vehicle classifications, and pedestrian and bicycle counts at intersections and along corridors. By applying automated video analysis techniques, RD Analytics reduces the need for manual data collection while improving efficiency, consistency, and data availability for planning studies, performance monitoring, and project development. A dedicated, high-performance computer will be required to run the software and process video files efficiently. This item will not change the overall UPWP budget.

The second item (Section 4-2), Titled "***MPO Vehicle Purchase - \$35,000.00***", the committee decided it was best not to purchase a vehicle at this time. This was changed to "***MPO Website Update - \$35,000.00***", this item was brought to the MPO's attention that the MPO will need to update its website to meet applicable ADA and federal accessibility requirements by improving compatibility with assistive technologies and ensuring accessible formats for plans, documents, data, and public involvement materials. These updates will support inclusive public participation, improve transparency, and ensure equitable access to MPO information. This item will not change the overall UPWP budget.

5. **[Safe Streets for All Comprehensive Action Plan](#)** – FHU. The plan will finish in late May or early June. The consultant team presented the refined High Injury Network

(HIN), incorporating feedback from prior Steering Committee discussions. Refinements included removing isolated rural segments with too few severe crashes to establish a meaningful pattern and improving continuity along corridors with statistically significant crash patterns. The project team also provided a preview of the draft crash data dashboard, noting that it is still under development and not yet ready for public release. The dashboard allows users to filter crashes by severity, time period, mode, and contributing factors, with an emphasis on fatal and serious injury crashes. A Cheyenne Transportation Safety Summit & Workshop was held on February 5, 2026, which was very successful. MPO continues to fill out quarterly reports for US DOT (FHWA/FTA).

6. **East Allison Road Corridor Study** - Stantec. RFQ plan was advertised September 20 & 27, 2025. The MPO received seven proposals from BenchMark Engineers, DJ&A, Y2 Consultants, JR Engineering, Kimley Horn, Stantec, and Ulteig. The East Allison Road Corridor Study will evaluate roadway, drainage, utility, and multimodal needs along East Allison Road in South Cheyenne. The study area extends from South Greeley Highway (US 85) east to College Drive. The study is divided into two phases, with Phase 1 advanced to ~30% design for greater accuracy at the US-85 gateway and extended to Avenue C, and Phase 2 delivered at ~10% conceptual level with centerline survey from Avenue C to the east end of the existing East Allison Road in Niobrara Industrial Park. The study will also include a review of a potential roundabout at the East Allison Road & Avenue C intersection. Currently, the contract was approved January 26, 2026, and a contract was signed with Stantec to start the study. A kick-off meeting was held on February 20, 2026, at 10:00 AM.
